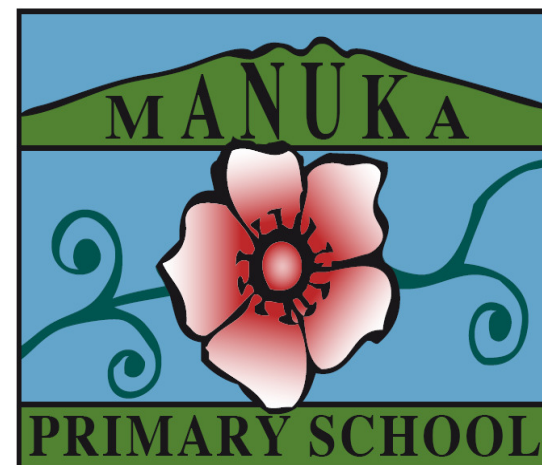




Mission Statement

The purpose of Manuka School is to provide an accepting and supportive environment, where everyone is encouraged to be a life long learner, striving to reach their maximum potential.



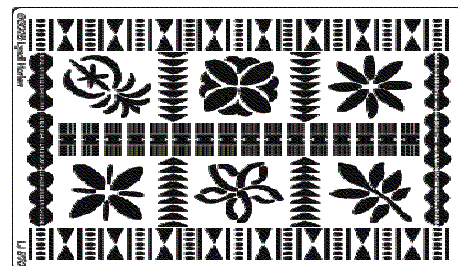
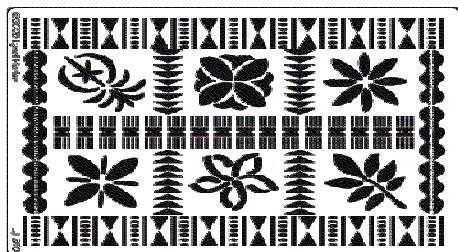
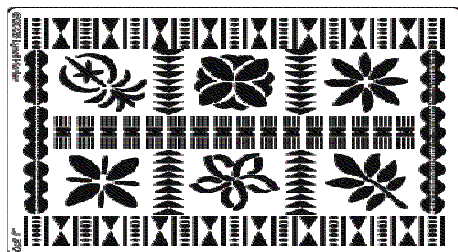
VISION STATEMENT
